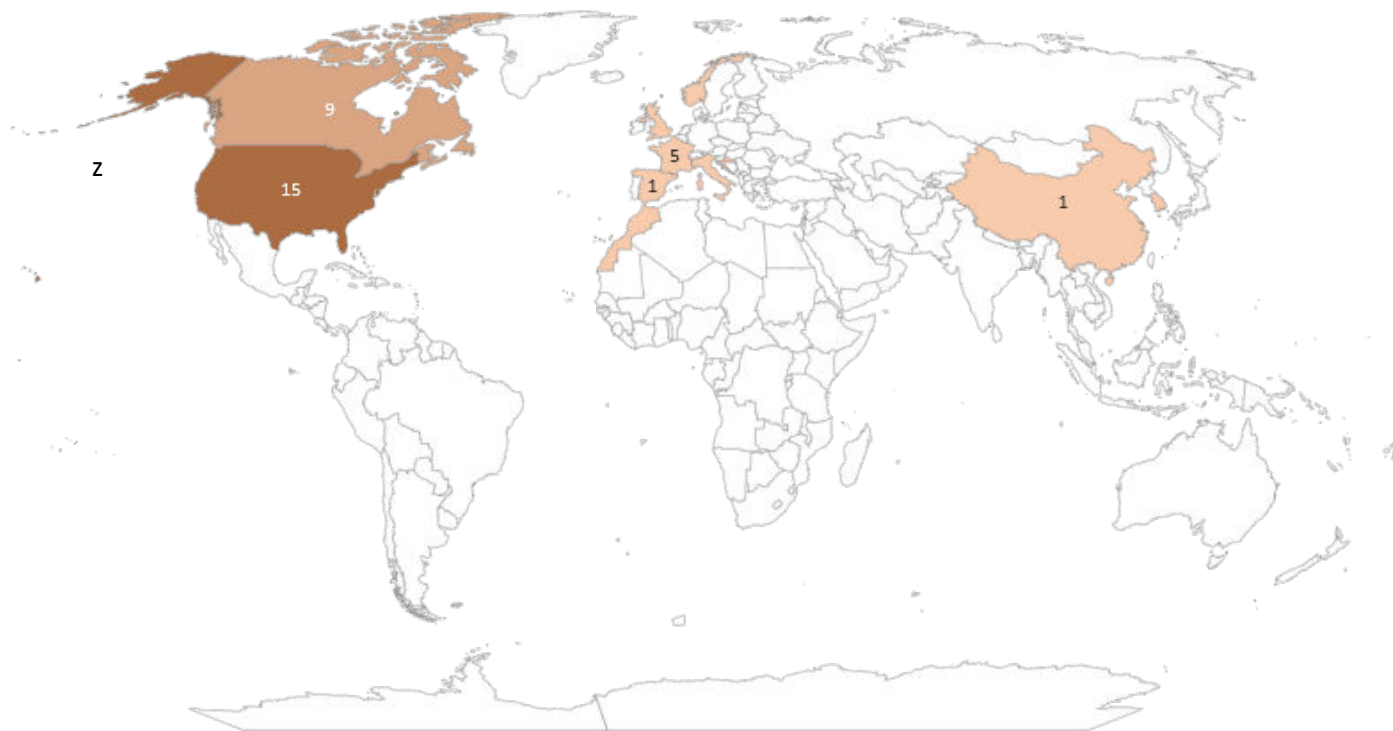

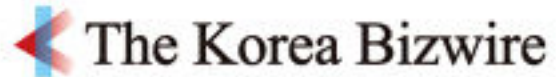

La solitude fait certes partie intégrante de ce sport, mais l'Optimist Team Race, qui se déroule en Principauté jusqu'à dimanche, a quelque peu modifié les règles. Ici, on coiffe la voile au pluriel. La compétition, réservée aux moins de 15 ans, se dispute par équipes de quatre. Et le temps, souvent une obsession dans la plupart des courses, est relégué au second plan. « L'idée n'est pas d'être le plus rapide seul de son côté, mais de naviguer en équipe et de franchir la ligne d'arrivée en équipe », tente d'expliquer Margaux Meslin, entraîneuse de l'équipe monégasque. Le tout, avant ses adversaires évidemment. Les huit bateaux sont sur l'eau en même temps sur un parcours jalonné de bouées qui dure environ dix minutes (comptant à 40 ou 50 minutes pour des régates individuelles). « C'est souvent un jeu où on se utilise les règles de priorités, de course et de pénalités pour arriver au maximum l'équipe d'en face. C'est ludique, actif et très dynamique ».

Cette notion de travail en équipe est assez rare dans ce sport. C'est ce qui fait, entre autres, le charme de la compétition. Car le reste de la saison se déroule autrement. « 90 % de l'année, ils font des régates individuelles où ils sont entre 150 et 400 participants à échelle nationale ou internationale », poursuit Margaux Meslin.

Un travail sur la cohésion d'équipe

Et pour s'adapter à ce changement radical, il a fallu du temps et une certaine préparation. « Ils sont relativement jeunes donc ce n'est pas quelque chose qu'ils ont l'habitude de faire. Il y avait pas mal de travail à faire en amont pour qu'ils apprennent à se connaître, à gérer leurs caractères et leurs émotions ».

On a fait des stages de cohésion, des briefings pour expliquer comment fonctionne chaque. 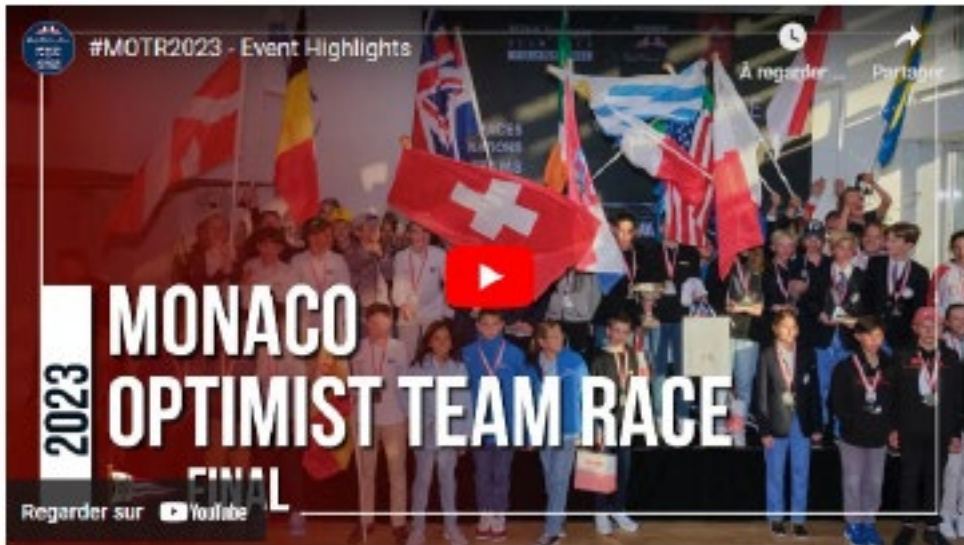

MONACO, Jan. 11, 2023 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) -- January kicks off a busy events programme for 2023, as the Yacht Club de Monaco celebrates 70 years since it was set up by Prince Rainier III. Presided since 1964 by HSH Prince Albert II of Monaco, this private club continues to honour its public service remit by organising world class events to promote the destination. The agenda fits within its 'Monaco, Capital of Advanced Yachting' approach, initiated by YCM to position the Principality as a centre of excellence in this sector.

The season begins with the 18th Monaco Optimist Team Race. Starting January the 18th, 64 under-14 sailors representing 16 nations gather to dispute a unique race. The format is unusual for an Optimist regatta, a match race being like a duel on water between teams of four as opposed to a fleet race of individuals. The result is 329 races in the hatch out rounds leading up to the finals and requiring finely tuned skills, tactics and above all teamwork. In the run up to the contest to hone their seacraft, teams are already on site to take part in an International Clinic (9-11 January 2023) supervised by Chris Atkins.

The spotlight then will be on one-designs, with the 10th Monaco Sportsboat Winter Series (2-3 February) and 38th Primo Cup-Triumphée Ciel Suisse (2-3 March). The best 370 teams, who have established their training base in the Principality, will meet again this month for Act III of the 10th Monaco Sportsboat Winter Series of monthly regattas, which has become a fixture on the calendar for international teams. Races are set to be tight for the fleet, currently led by YCM's Ludovic Faselli on Jorda followed by Casper Peterson (Moonlight II) and Stefano Roberti (Piccolini), also from YCM.

Moving on to March, during the Monaco Ocean Week (20-25), organised by the Prince Albert II of Monaco Foundation, Monaco Oceanographic Institute and the Scientific Centre of Monaco, YCM will be responsible for the yachting component of this week focused on protecting the oceans. On Thursday 23rd March at the YCM there will be four events, starting with the 12th Environmental Symposium dedicated to the 10th Monaco Energy Boat Challenge on the theme 'Ensuring the Future for a more Sustainable Yachting'. This highlight precedes the 27th Captains' Forum that brings owners, captains and superyacht industry leaders together, the theme this time will be 'Superyacht Commitment: Management, Leadership & Marketing'.

After the success of the Monaco Smart & Sustainable Marine Rendezvous (next one at YCM, 24-25 September 2023), H3 (Monaco Marina Management) is launching the first Monaco Smart Yacht Rendezvous, a networking event that continues on Friday 24th March culminating in the Smart Innovative Yacht Awards. Thursday 23rd March concludes with the 3rd YCM Explorer Awards by La Belle Classe Superyachts. Organised under the presidency of HSH Prince Albert II since 2019, it has been recognising owners who stand out for their commitments to protect the marine environment, be it in the design of their yacht or its navigation.

L'Art de Vivre la Mer is the motto of the Yacht Club de Monaco. To illustrate it and to put the spotlight on gourmet cuisine at sea as being another facet of yachting professions, the YCM will organise on 30th March the 4th edition of the Superyacht Chef competition, with an international jury chaired by the two-time three Michelin star chef Yannick Alléno.

In July, the 10th Monaco Energy Boat Challenge will take place (3-8 July). Helping build tomorrow's future is a top priority for YCM, an ambition it pursues through the Monaco Energy Boat Challenge for alternative energy sources. For the last ten years, this event has been bringing young engineers from technical colleges and universities the world over into contact with yachting industry players.

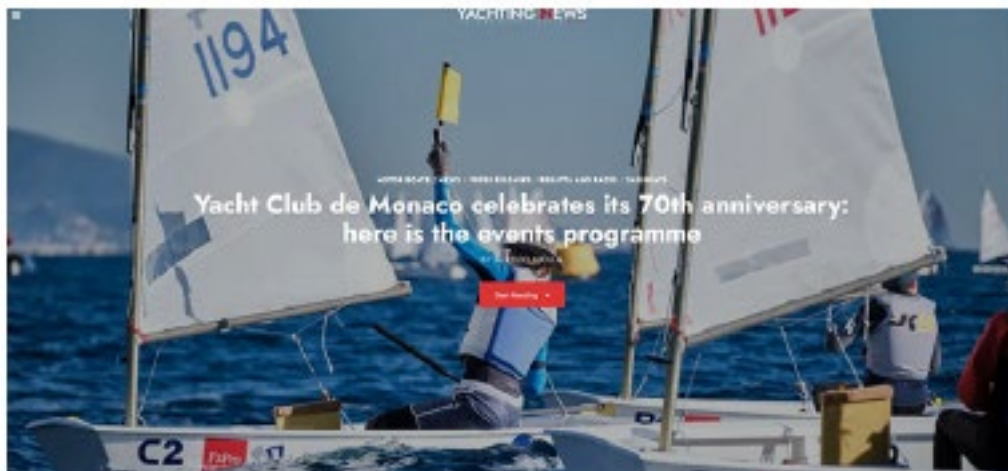
